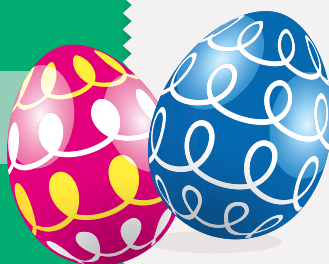

Prepare for an emergency

1. Know your zone

Moera is in tsunami and flood zones, so check your address on the maps to know your risks.

An earthquake can cause a tsunami. If you feel an earthquake that is either longer than a minute OR strong enough to knock you down, as soon as the shaking stops, move inland or to higher ground immediately.

If the earthquake is long or strong, **GET GONE! Don't wait for an alert – get to safety!**

2. Have a grab bag ready

Pack essential items in a small backpack you can grab quickly. Keep it light and easy to carry. Use the Grab Bag checklists to pack wisely.
